Subject: H10 Bletcham Way Extension – Phase 2 Old Farm Park to Wavendon

Dear Resident,

H10 Bletcham Way Extension Phase 2

We are pleased to inform you that **Galliford Try** has been appointed as the principal contractor to deliver **Phase 2 of the H10 Bletcham Way Extension**.

This project will provide additional highway capacity to support new housing growth within the **South East Milton Keynes Urban Extension (SEMK)** and Church Farm developments, whilst improving the resilience of the local transport network.

When will the works take place?

Enabling works will begin in October 2026 and are anticipated to last approximately three months.

Works will include:

- Site clearance and preparation
- Site compound and security installation
- Construction of a temporary car park
- Redway construction
- Closure of part of Bletcham Way between Browns Wood Roundabout and Gregories Drive

Main Works - December 2026 to Spring 2028 (approx. 15 months)

Works will include:

- Construction of approximately 1km of new road
- Enlargement of the Britten Grove/Gregories Drive roundabout
- New bridge over Byrd Crescent
- New signalised controlled crossing (Pegasus) for pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians
- Redway and footway extensions
- New streetlighting
- Extensive landscaping, including over 100 new trees
- Noise mitigation bunds
- Utility service diversions
- Two new attenuation ponds
- Reconstruction of Byrd Crescent carriageway

A temporary car park will be provided for residents, school staff and visitors throughout the construction works. Contractor vehicles will not be permitted to use this facility

How will this affect you?

Whilst every effort will be made to minimise disruption, residents may experience temporary impacts during construction:

- Pedestrian and emergency service access will be maintained at all times.
- Pedestrian and Vehicle access to properties on Byrd Crescent, Gregories Drive and Britton Grove will be maintained.
- The Byrd Crescent Redway and footpath will be temporarily closed for the major bridge construction works, with signed diversion routes provided.
- Bus services along Gregories Drive will be temporarily diverted or suspended during some phases of the works. Bus stop suspensions will be posted onsite, and information will be available on the Council's webpage – see link below.
- On safety grounds the bridleway through the site will be closed for the duration of the works.

Construction traffic will access the site via designated routes and will not use local residential roads.
