

PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (STRATFORD ROAD (PART), WOLVERTON) (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council intends, in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice, to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to **temporarily prohibit vehicles other than buses from waiting or loading along Stratford Road, Wolverton – From outside The North Western Pub to its junction with Radcliffe Street on its westbound carriageway**, whilst bus stops are relocated in this location during the Agora redevelopment works.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for buses and emergency services on operational duties.

The closures will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the TSRGD 2016 (The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016). All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to the works taking place.

The temporary restrictions will be in force on the date shown when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs displayed in the affected parts of roads.

The proposed Order will come into operation from 5th October 2026 and remain in effect for 18 Months or until the works have been has completed, whichever is the sooner.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
